The Port of Los Angeles (POLA), in collaboration with various terminal partners and the Harbor Community Benefits Foundation (HCBF), is seeking funding to accelerate its transition towards zero-emission on-terminal operations by 2030. This ambitious project will significantly reduce air pollution at the port, aligning with the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Clean Ports Program's objectives to support the port industry's shift towards sustainable and resilient infrastructure.

The proposed project will deploy a wide variety of zero emissions equipment across the Port, install one of the first global shore-power support systems for auto carrier vessels, and implement a unique and ambitious community-driven effort to both deploy zero emissions grants funded by the community as well as coordinate clean technology engagement efforts between the Port and the surrounding community managed by HCBF. This project builds on POLA's years of experience in demonstrating and deploying zero emissions technologies into service, including the world's first deployment of a zero emissions Top Handler in 2019.
